PROJECT PURPOSE



The Holiday Playworks Funding has enabled the team to provide play opportunities across a variety of communities in Conwy during all holidays.

We had been able to delivery a variety of Play Events and Community Events where there would be no provision or opportunities these have included:

STAFFING AND RESOURCES

Sessions are delivered in parks and open spaces across Conwy. Based on Play sufficiency Research and Actions in Conwy's Action we also felt it was important to plan and deliver sessions in less 'formal play space' such as forest, beaches, community spaces identified by the children of Conwy to be rich and inclusive spaces for their play.

All Playworkers have a L2APPS in playwork which they have completed with =in the first 6 months of being in their role.

A core group of playworkers have been working towards their P3 certificate in Playwork this academic year. Staff across the play team also hold the following qualifications First Aid, Safeguarding, Food Hygiene, Food Nutrition and a vairety of sports coaching qualifications which supports a vairety and range in choices at play sessions for participation and enagagement.

FEEDBACK

78% OF CHILDREN STATED THAT THE SESSIONS SUPPORTED THEM TO PLAY WITH FRIENDS AND MAKE NEW FRIENDS IN THEIR COMMUNITY.



100% OF CHILDREN REPORTED BEING MORE ACTIVE AND RUNNING AROUND

97% OF CHILDREN REPORTED THAT THEY HAD TRIED NEW THINGS

81% OF PARENTS TOLD US THAT PLAYING OUT HAD SUPPORTED THEIR CHILD'S SPEECH, LANGUAGE AND COMMUNICATION SKILLS.

92% OF PARENTS TOLD US THAT PLAYING OUT SESSIONS HELPED THEIR CHILD'S EMOTIONAL AND MENTAL WELL-BEING.

78% OF PARENTS TOLD US THAT PLAYING OUT SESSIONS HAD HELPED SUPPORT THEIR CHILD'S LEARNING AND DEVELOPMENT NEEDS.



92% OF CHILDREN STATED THAT PLAYING OUT SESSIONS HELPED TO WITH RELATIONSHIPS

100% OF CHILDREN REPORTED FEELING HAPPIER WHEN ATTENDING HOLIDAY SESSIONS.



47% OF PARENTS TOLD US THEY HAD BEEN TO A NEW LOCATION DURING HOLIDAY SESSIONS
